Re: 2024 National High School Mock Trial Championship—Information update

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the 2024 National High School Mock Trial Championship in Wilmington! Please read the information in this memorandum carefully.

You are receiving this memorandum because you have registered to attend the 2024 National High School Mock Trial Championship as an adult observer / spectator. The below information will help ensure that you have the best experience possible at the competition.

I. Registration and Check-in

All spectators are required to register in Tabroom prior to the event (note, when we say all, if you are traveling with children who will be under your control at all times, they do not need to separately register as an observer). In order to receive your badges, you will need to check in at the registration desk—located in the Atrium Lobby of the Chase Center on the Riverfront. At that time you will also receive any awards celebration tickets that you personally have purchased. If your team purchased tickets for you to the awards celebration, then you will need to pick up tickets from your team.

PLEASE NOTE: If you have not purchased tickets for the awards celebration, you will not be allowed to attend.

II. Friday night event

The Friday night event is open to spectators, with the purchase of tickets to the Blue Rocks game, conveniently located at Frawley Stadium on the Riverfront. We have arranged to offer tickets to the Blue Rocks game in the Upper Deck for only \$10 per ticket. You can access the information for ordering tickets by [clicking here](#).

III. Competition

Please note that you will be required to have a badge to enter the courthouse, which also means that you must have registered prior to the competition. You cannot register at the

Courthouse (although you can pick your badge up at the Courthouse on the day of the competition if you already registered).

Please remember that the Courthouse (at least on Friday) is a functioning court of law. There are several trials that are going on Friday.

Please do not disturb these trials or go to floors where your team is not assigned or courtrooms where your team is not competing. Your teams are supposed to make you aware of the Rules of Competition (which are available [here](#)) and of the Code of Conduct (which is available [here](#)). **Please pay special attention to Rule 4.13.** Violations of this rule by you may negatively impact your student's team.

Please do not bring food or drink into the Courthouse and please do not leave anything in any courtroom.

Please also pay special attention to Rule 4.14, which regards videotaping / photography.

IV. Awards Celebration

The awards celebration is a ticketed event. There is a maximum capacity for the event. We expect that we will sell out, although we will continue to sell tickets at Registration until capacity is reached. Once capacity is reached, you will not be able to attend. Registration as an observer does not grant you access to the awards celebration.

At the awards ceremony, seating will be first come, first served, with the following proviso: tables marked as reserved are for the teams. Please do not sit at a reserved table. You will be asked to leave the awards ceremony if you do.
